For IRGPX we will also give more importance to EFI as we change the rules for the Underbone GP and Legends Underbone events to 150 EFI only in recognition of the direction of our local manufacturers. This is in keeping with IRGP's creed to push for change in the rules to be relevant to the industry.

More importantly, the event is now recognized by the Philippine Sports Commission (PSC) and I would like to thank the officers and Board of the

HOW TO GET THERE

From Manila

1. Take South Luzon Expressway, exit at Carmona, turn right going to Carmona proper to Governor's Drive. Go straight until you see the Shell gas station on your left before GMA. Turn left into the small street and you will see the entrance road to Carmona Race Track.
2. Take service road until Alabang, take the National Highway past Muntinlupa, Putatan and San Pedro onwards. Turn right going to Carmona via Governor's Drive. Go straight for about 6 kilometers until you see the Shell gas station on your left. Turn left into the small street and you will see the entrance road to Carmona Race Track.
3. Take service road until Alabang, turn right at Alabang Zapote road toward Alabang Town Center and turn left at Daang Hari. Go straight until you hit Molino road and turn left towards Paliparan. Turn right at Governor's Drive. Go straight for about 1 kilometer past GMA market until you see the Shell gas station on your right. You will see the small street entrance road to Carmona Race Track.

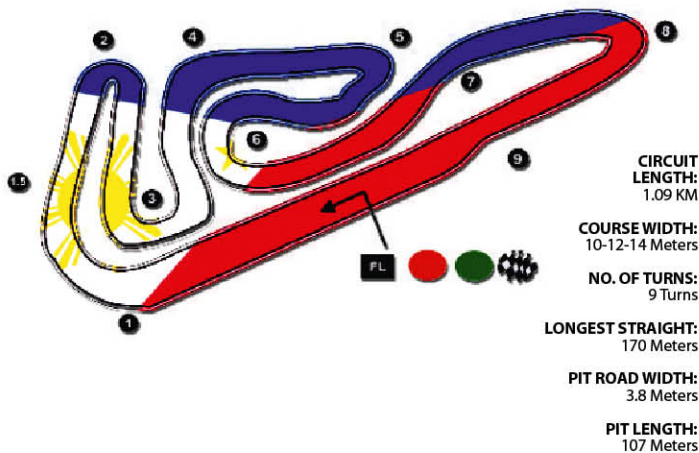

FLAGS



Green Flag
The track is clear.



Blue Flag
Indicates to a rider that he is about to be overtaken or is about to be lapped.



Red Flag
When the race or practice is being interrupted, the red flag will be waved. The red flag may also be used to close the track.



Checkered Flag
Indicates the finish of the race or practice.



Yellow Flag
Indicates that there is danger ahead. The riders must slow down. Overtaking is forbidden up until the point where the green flag is shown.



White Flag
One lap to go.



Black Flag
The rider must stop at the pit at the end of the current lap and cannot start.

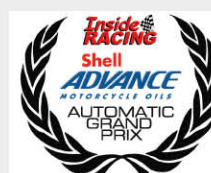

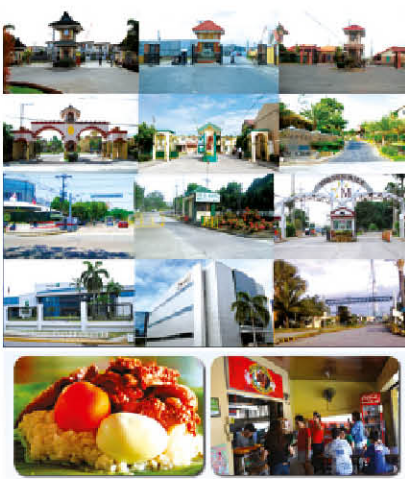

Carmona is approximately 22 kilometers from the Ninoy Aquino International Airport (NAIA) and is easily accessible by land transportation through the South Luzon Expressway (SLEX). From Manila, Carmona is approximately 36 kilometers South and may also be accessed through Manila-Cavite Expressway, Aguinaldo Highway and Governor's Drive road network.

Industrialization in the 90's account for the rapid growth of Carmona's business community. From an otherwise quaint agricultural town in the 1950's, the opening of the South Luzon Expressway and the Governor's Drive became Carmona's moving force and advantage as it brought major business districts and ports in Metro Manila.

The bulk of commercial activities came from retail and wholesale enterprise which comprise more than 700 establishments. Following this are contracting, foodshoppes, amusement and sports

50 commercial establishments and the Macaria Business Park which houses Walter Mart Carmona and the soon-to-rise Carmona, Hospital.

The famous Binalot is believed to have started in Carmona. Two major binalot houses are famous for this specialty. A number of high-end to more affordable local restaurants sprung out in different parts of the municipality offering a kaleidoscope of flavors and specialities.

With its primary advocacy of promoting healthy citizenry, the LGU provides quality health care services in its 15-bed community hospital, Pagamutang Bayan ng Carmona, Main Health Center, 11 Health Stations, 2 Clinical Laboratories and Regional Water Laboratory.

USRA IS NOW RECOGNIZED AND ACCREDITED *by the Philippine Sports Commission (PSC)*

In October 2016, motorcycle racing sanctioning body USRA was officially recognized and accredited by PSC.

The Philippine Sports Commission (PSC) serves as the sole policy-making and coordinating body of amateur sports development programs and institutions in the Philippines. PSC was created through Republic Act No. 6847 in 1990 and it provides leadership, formulates policies and sets the priorities and directions of national sports promotion and developments, particularly giving emphasis on grassroots participation. Mr. William Ramirez is the current leader of the PSC.

PSC's mission statement is to serve as the prime catalyst and advocate for the propagation and development of Philippine sports by helping shape policies and setting priorities through coordinating and implementing a national sports program; creating equitable opportunities for participation in sports by all sectors; providing assistance to stakeholders and partners; supporting the specially talented athletes for high

level competitions; and promoting the development of physical qualities and moral values which is the basis of sports. Its vision is to be a Commission with a unified sports program which will enhance the quality of life of the Filipinos, instill national pride and attain international prestige through excellence in sports. PSC aims to achieve increased participation and excellence in sports by Filipinos.

The Unified Sports and Racing Association for Motorcycles, Inc. (USRA) was established on May 28, 2011 after the untimely demise of the legendary Maico Buncio. The riders themselves have called for unity, and concluded that it is the proper time for the circuit racing riders to form a Riders' Association with safety as the main concern. The primary objectives of this association are to improve and maintain high safety standards and provisions for both the riders and spectators and to ensure that circuit racing in the Philippines will continue to develop.

The association primarily deals with the safety of permanent road racing facilities as well as temporary circuits including races held on public roads or parking lots. It is envisioned that this association will be an effective tool towards the improvement of safety to ensure the continuity of underbone and scooter circuit racing in the Philippines. USRA is an association that comprises all riders and teams participating in underbone and scooter circuit racing in the Philippines, representing their collected voice in the decision-making process with regards to safety. The association works alongside event organizers, track owners, promoters and sanctioning bodies to maintain high safety standards and improve the safety of the sport overall. The five safety concerns of USRA are Track Safety/Conditions, Riders' Safety, Spectator's Safety, Marshals and On Track Medical Assistance.
